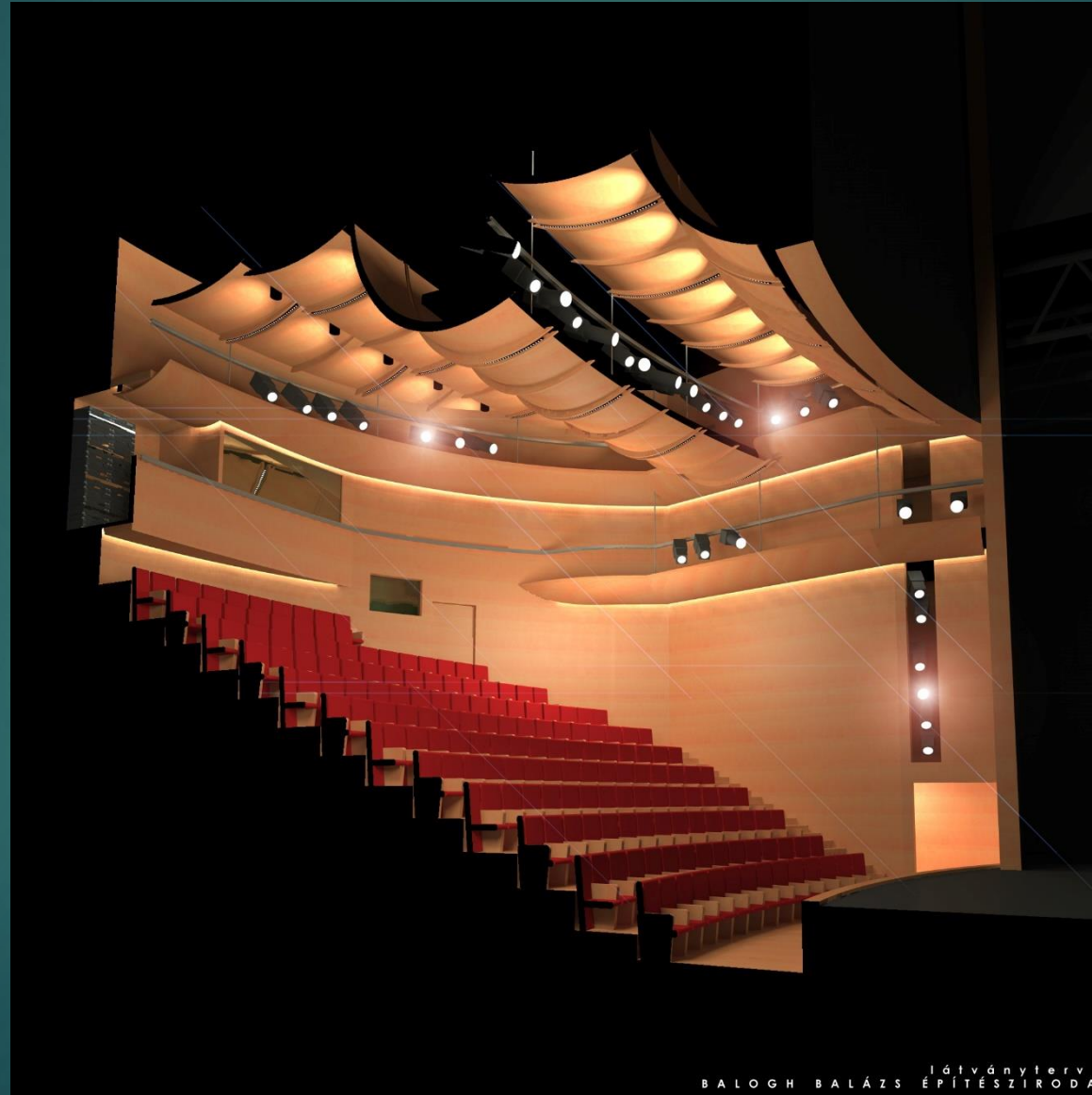


Debrecen - 2023



Debrecen

- ▶ Debrecen is Hungary's second-largest city, after Budapest, the regional centre of the Northern Great Plain region and the seat of Hajdú-Bihar County.
- ▶ It is one of the Hungarian people's most important cultural centres. Debrecen was also the capital city of Hungary during the revolution in 1848–1849.
- ▶ The city also served as the capital of Hungary by the end of the World War II in 1944–1945.
- ▶ It is home of the University of Debrecen.
- ▶ Airport - flights from and to 6 cities (2021): Eindhoven, Larnaca (Cyprus), London, Paris, Palma de Mallorca, Santorini



The University of Debrecen

- ▶ The University of Debrecen is a university located in Debrecen, Hungary. It is the oldest continuously operating institution of higher education in Hungary (since 1538) with approximately 30.000 students.
- ▶ The university has a well established programme in the English language for international students, particularly in the Medical field, which first established education in English in 1986. There are nearly 6000 international students studying at the university.
